

## Service Club Leadership

## Each club should have the following officers:

President – Plans and Conducts meetings in conjunction with the Sponsor Advisor
Vice President – Conducts meetings in absence of President, or as assigned.
Secretary – Maintains the written records of the club

- Prepare a record of each meeting (minutes or action list) and share with club members. Including assignments made.
- Maintain membership list & communicate with members
  - Notice of upcoming meetings & Assignment reminders

Treasurer – This office may be combined with the office of Secretary

- Keeps record of any dues, donations & expenses
- Complies with school requirements

**Sacramento Student Council Member** – This position might be filled by the President, Vice President, or another member of the club.

- Report on club activities at monthly student council meetings 1st Thur. @
   6:00 pm at JAA Roseville
- Communicates information from Student Council to the club

Other Officers - If possible a director for each class (9-12) should be elected.

**Suggested Committees** – Each committee should have a chair. In smaller clubs the chair may comprise a committee of one, or the assignment may be given to one of the other officers. In larger clubs each member should be encouraged to serve on one of the committees.

**Service Committee** – Organizes at least two service projects during each semester. This may include participation in multi-school projects.

Education Committee – Organizes activities to promote civic education.

**Leadership Committee** – Plans activities to teach leadership skills and gives members an opportunity to practice them.
